Eligibility and requirements (full-time degree):

- Citizen of ASEAN member countries (excluding Indonesia), South Korea, Japan, China and Taiwan.
- Must be accepted for admission to master program (regular, taught in Bahasa Indonesia) in UGM for the 2019/2020 academic year (start on August 2019).
- Hold a Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Science, Medicine/Health, Geography, Agriculture, Forestry, Economics, Law, Social Sciences and Humanity, or related fields.
- Excellent Bachelor Degree academic record (GPA of at least 3.0 on 4.0 GPA scale).
- Good proficiency in English (score of at least 500 for TOEFL or 5.0 of IELTS or equivalent).
- Below 30 years-old.
- Curriculum Vitae, motivation letter, and letter of recommendation from Bachelor's supervisor.

Dual/Double Degree Master Program

Eligibility requirements (Dual/Double Degree):

- Must have enrolled in home university for at least 1 semester.
- Must be accepted for admission in a master program in UGM for the 2019/2020 academic year (January 2019 or August 2019).
- Hold a Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Science, Medicine/Health, Geography, Agriculture, Forestry, Economics, Law, Social Sciences and Humanity, or related fields.
- Must have a clear research plan with joint supervision, specific plan for joint publication, and plan for thesis defence.
- Excellent Bachelor Degree academic record (GPA of at least 3.0 on 4.0 GPA scale).
- Good proficiency in English (score of at least 500 for TOEFL or 5.0 of IELTS or equivalent).
- Below 30 years-old.
